

WHAT IS AUTOCROSS?

Autocross is a timed contest of driving skill. Speeds and hazards to spectators, participants, and property do not exceed those found in normal, legal highway driving. We think it is much more fun than street driving and you can't get a speeding ticket! Best of all, you can enter in your everyday street car!

This school will introduce you to Solo driving, teach you some valuable driving skills and give you a chance to try them out in a controlled environment. There will be in-car instruction from experienced drivers and coaches. Lunch is included in your entry fee as well as an entry to the first Autocross event of the 2018 season on Sunday, January 28th.

SAFETY

All vehicles must pass safety inspection on the following points prior to running: seat belts, throttle return action, secure battery, no oil or antifreeze leaks, adequate brake pedal, tire condition, wheel bearings.

All loose items, snap-on hubcaps, detachable fender skirts and trim rings must be removed. Real shoes are required (no sandals or flip-flops). Helmets are required (Snell M2005/SA2005 or newer) with a limited number of loaner helmets available. NO ALCOHOL ON SITE - NO MINORS ON GRID.

Includes entry to Fresno SCCA Autocross Event #1 to be held on 1/28/18.

The Performance Driving School starts with an introductory "chalk talk" classroom session at 6PM on Friday, January 26 at MB2 Raceway at Sierra Vista Mall in Clovis. This session will introduce and educate novices about the sport of autocross.

The driving portion of the school begins at 9AM at the **Fresno Fairgrounds** Saturday, January 27. Enter at the north end of the fairgrounds from Kings Canyon Rd. Please arrive early to prepare yourself and car. Remove all loose items and make sure you have enough fuel to last you throughout the school. There is a Chevron station at Cedar and Kings Canyon in case anyone would like to fill up prior or during the class.
